

**Jericho Road Church's
COVID-19 Policy and Procedures**

1. **1 Service:** We will be offering service on Sunday at 10am. We will continue to have our service steamed online on Facebook Live for those who wish to participate from home.
2. **Social Distancing:** We will block off every other pew, to allow for proper spacing. We will have a seperate family entrance for families to enter for easier kid's check in..
3. **Kids' Ministry:** There will be JRoad Kids Ministry offered for ages 2 year and up. For the first couple weeks of returning to the building we will not offer the nursery for children 23 months and younger. If you have a child that is 23 months old and younger we have set up a family room in the JRoad Kids basement area for you to hang out with your child and watch the service live streamed. If you are checking your kids into the JRoad Kids ministry, please come early enough to check in your kids, and walk them to their classroom. We will also have kid's ministry bags available for parents who wish to keep their kids in service. *Kids ministry rooms and procedures will be evaluated on a weekly basis. So we appreciate your grace and flexibility as our staff and volunteers navigate this new season.
4. **Coffee/Snacks:** We will be serving coffee and bottled water. We will evaluate in the next month.
5. **Hand Sanitizer:** We will have hand sanitizing stations throughout our building, and we ask that you use them appropriately.
6. **Contactless Service:** We will not be shaking hands at the door, and we won't be having intermission in the service. Instead, our greeters will be holding doors open as you arrive.
7. **Masks:**
 - o Masks are strongly recommended in the church building and while in common spaces. The mask may be removed while seated.
8. **Thorough Cleaning:** We will clean the pews, and high touchpoints in the bathrooms, and throughout the building during the week.
9. **Temperature Checks:** All staff and volunteers will be undergoing a temperature check before they step into their serving roles.
10. **When should I stay home?** If you are feeling sick or running a fever at all, please show responsibility by staying home and engaging with us in our online service. If you are waiting for a COVID test result, please stay home until you get your negative test results. If you have been around anyone who has tested positive, please stay home until you get tested.
